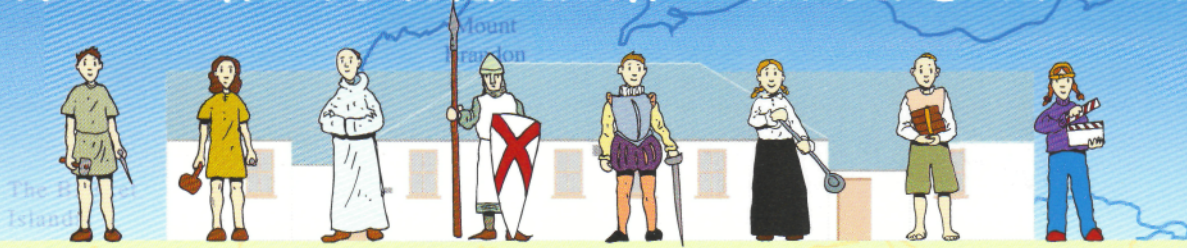

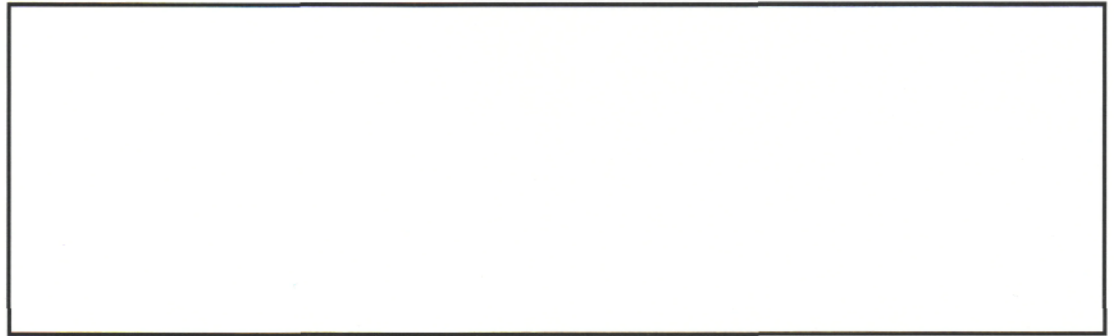

(5000 years ago). What was ground in the quern stone and why?

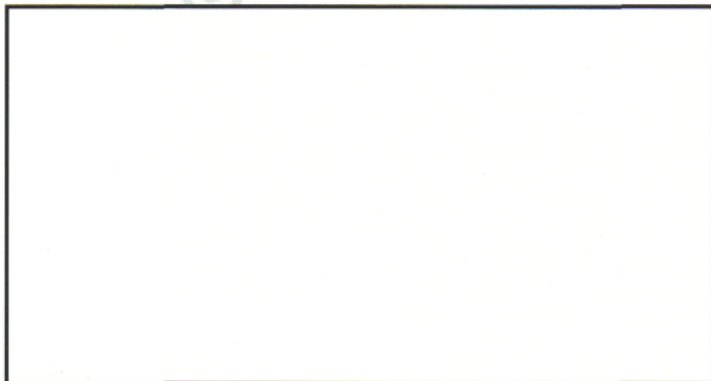


The Bronze Age

Ogham stones

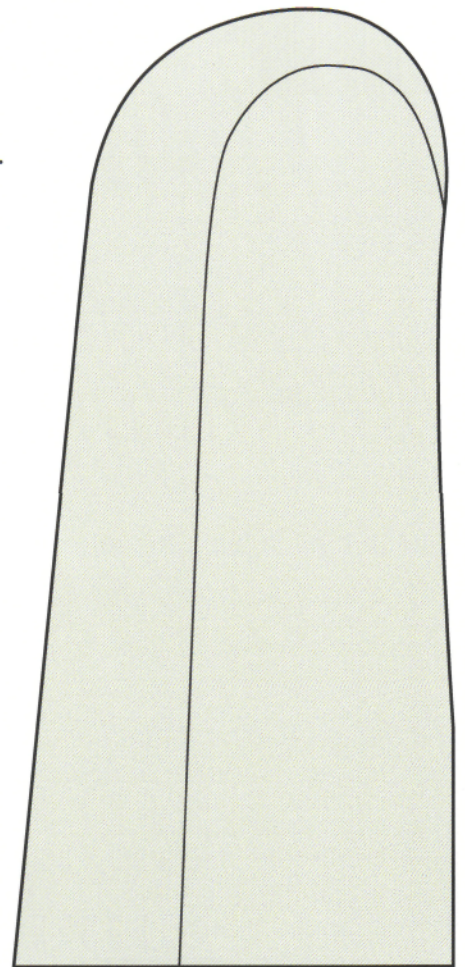


Ogham (pronounced ooohm) is a form of writing used in Ireland about 1500 years ago. There are six ogham stones in the museum.

Write your own name (using the alphabet below) on the stone drawn here.>

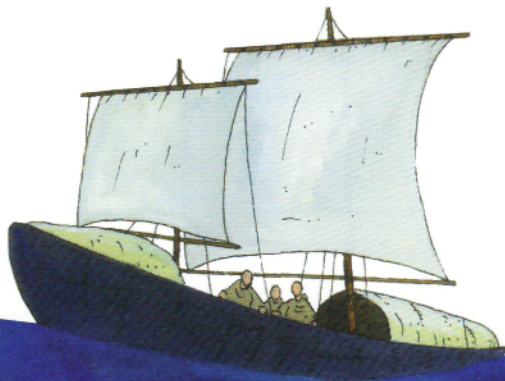

Find the model of Tim Severin's boat.

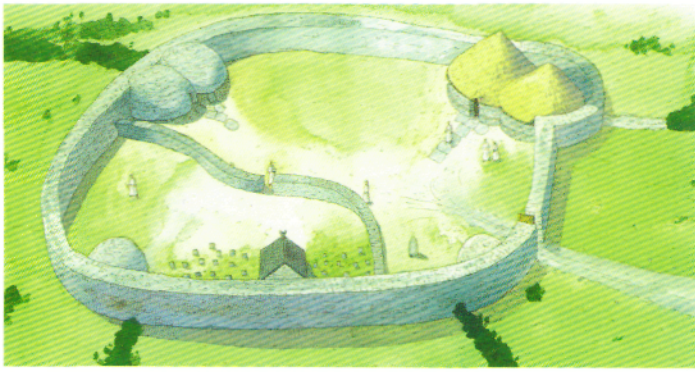
Severin sailed to America in this tiny boat following in the footsteps of St. Brendan.

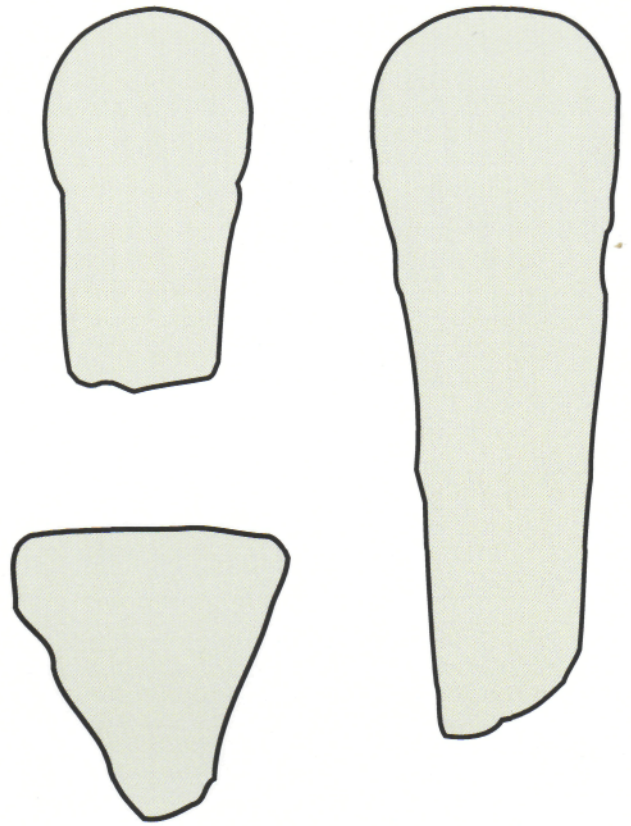


Early Christianity

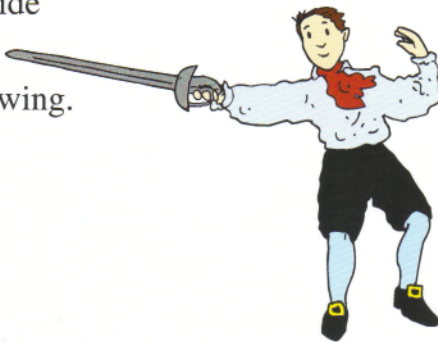

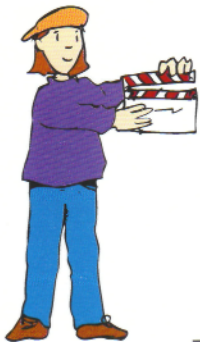
